

Parent/Guardian Information & Rates - PE Program 2023-2024



Fees include one 2-Hour Lesson, Use of Equipment for the Full Day, and Skill-Appropriate Lift Privileges.

*You must be at least 5 years old to be considered a kindergartener.
 ** You must be at least 8 years old to snowboard.
 ***Chaperones must be ADULTS (i.e., no longer in High School)
NOTE: There is a \$18 fee for switching activities during the day.

Scholarships:

No child is turned away because of inability to pay. Please communicate your needs with your school. It is 100% at the schools' discretion to determine financial hardship. Showdown is only interested in the total number of students to be scholarshiped, not who the individual students are.

Notes on Program Fees:

- The fee for the PE Program covers the lesson only. The lift ticket and rental equipment are included at no charge. Regardless of whether students have their own equipment or a season pass, the fee is the same.
 - **If your students is a Showdown Season Passholder**, we ask the schools to require them to participate in the PE Program under the same rules as everyone else. The point of the PE Program is to provide lessons based on students ability. Anyone can become a better skier or boarder. That is the point of this education. We have lessons for all skill levels.
- Any student on the final registration sheet who does not attend the trip will be charged a \$5 cancellation fee, The final registration is submitted by the lead teacher 2 weeks before the scheduled trip.
- Chaperone rates are available to **one adult for every five students**. If you are interested in becoming a chaperone please reach out to your school.
 - Exceptions are granted for escorts of Special Needs Students.
- Community Rates are available for other adults and family members who will be traveling with the school, but who are not Teachers or Chaperones. Siblings whose grade is not included in the PE Day will be charged the Community Rate. Adult Community Members are not required to perform the duties required of official Chaperones, such as assisting the students as they get ready or travel with the school. As a Community Member, the day is yours! Go play! Community members are not included in the school paperwork; they just declare themselves a "Community Member" at the ShedQuarters or Rental Shop and proceed through with the appropriate paperwork and payment.

Payment Options

The Teacher Coordinator pays for their PE Day in a single transaction. PLEASE MAKE YOUR CHECK OUT TO YOUR SCHOOL, NOT SHOWDOWN.

Regrading Food

- No outside lunches, crockpots/instant pots/rice cookers/etc. will be permitted in the lodge.
- Showdown's \$10.00 PE Student Lunch Program includes:
 - Choice of hamburger/cheeseburger, chicken strips, hot dog, or mac & cheese
 - French fries
 - Brownie or cookie
 - Small fountain drink of choice
- NO CHILD will be turned away because of a lack of ability to pay. Please communicate with your Teacher/Coordinator regarding scholarship lunches.

Students with Special Needs

Our partnership with Eagle Mount ensures that students with developmental or physical disabilities can enjoy skiing and snowboarding right alongside their friends. Any student who requires specialized assistance is eligible. Eagle Mount's services are not an additional cost. **Please contact Eagle Mount directly at 406.454.1449** or joe.eaglemountgf@gmail.com at least one month prior to your visit to arrange for their services. Parents *must* sign an Eagle Mount liability release in addition to the Showdown Montana release.

Teacher/Chaperone Responsibilities

One teacher is the coordinator and does all communication with Hannah Patrick, our PE Coordinator. The other teachers assist the Teacher/Coordinator as needed. Chaperones are responsible for aiding students in getting dressed, retrieving and keeping track of rental equipment, ensuring that students make it to lessons on time, and supervising students when they are not in a lesson. Equipment and lift tickets will be provided to Chaperones ***only after*** all students have made their way through the Rental Shop and out to the lesson area. Chaperones are welcome to participate in lessons at no charge, so long as they are not disruptive and/or occupy a disproportionate amount of the instructor's time. Our first priority must be the students. Adults not willing to perform the duties listed above should come as Community members.
