Tying the knot at the base, or at the top of this 8,200 ft summit in the Little Belt Mountains, is sure to be an experience like none other for you and your guests. Showdown Montana offers plenty of options and opportunities to create a couples dream wedding. Couples can choose to exchange vows on top of the mountain complete with sprawling views or at the base with the ski area as the scenic background. A handmade arbor made from locally harvested wood can be included to enhance each setting.

Once vows are exchanged, the reception can take place in the mountain lodge or on the deck outside the lodge where views of the ski area and meadow are breathtaking. These spaces can be set up and decorated in a variety of ways to cater to a couples taste. A dance floor, lodging, commercial kitchen, full service bar, lights, centerpieces, and a day of coordinator are some examples of Showdown's decor and amenity options.

Enjoy private access for 3 days & 2 nights; arrive anytime after 3pm on Friday and depart by noon on Sunday.

- Tables & chairs with seating up to 320
- Use of any Showdown wedding decor

- Unlimited tent camping
- Camper parking in parking lots (no hookups or dumping)

The All-Inclusive package, 320 guests max, includes everything from the Summer Weekend Wedding Package plus:

- Four shuttle vehicles including 2 round trips from White Sulphur Springs
- Garbage removal, and deep cleaning of the entire lodge upon departure

Package Cost: \$10,000

PACKAGE ADDITIONS

- Use of the commercial kitchen & appliances: \$300
- Mountain House: \$500 per night + \$500 refundable damage deposit
- Bar setup + staffing on Saturday: \$500 + cost of alcohol
- Catering: Customizable menus available
- Dance floor + installation and put away in the bar: \$300-\$600 depending on location
- Shuttle services: \$1,000 for up to four vehicles and two round trips to/from The Edith in White Sulphur Springs. Or \$250 per vehicle inclduing two round trips
- Discounted rooms at The Edith Hotel in White Sulphur Springs (bookings based on availability)
- Returning the lodge to how you found it. Garbage removal, deep clean of the entire lodge upon departure. \$2,000

We charge an 18% gratuity on all services.

FAQ

- What is your noise policy?
 - We do not have time restrictions for noise/music.
- How many guests can stay in the Mountain House?
 - The Mountain House is a 4 bedroom, 2 bath house that sleeps 10.
- Do you offer photography services?
 - Not in-house, but we have numerous contacts for photography, videography, drone coverage, wedding cakes & cupcakes and portable restroom vendors who have experience at our venue and that we're happy to share with you.
- Are you LGBTQIA+ friendly?
 - ABSOLUTELY!
- What is the bar policy?
 - We offer a full service bar with customizable menus & it can be fully or partially hosted, cash/credit card bar or any combination of the two. All alcohol must be purchased and served by Showdown Montana. The renting party and all guests are forbidden from bringing alcoholic beverages on the premises.
- · What are your catering options?
 - We offer completely customizable menus for parties of any size and budget & can accommodate any requests or dietary restrictions. Our services also include buffet setup, cleanup, necessary serving items, and nice sturdy disposable dishes, silverware & napkins. We do not allow outside caterers: catered by Showdown Montana or self prepared.
- Do you host winter weddings?
 - Yes, please email rickey@showdownmontana.com to inquire about winter weddings.
- What is the initial deposit amount and when is it due?
 - In order to secure your date, a 50% deposit is due at the time of booking.
- Can we use the chairlift?
 - No, due to new laws we are no longer able to load any foot traffic on any of our chairlifts but you
 are welcome to sit on a chair for photos. There is an access road that takes you to the top of the
 mountain.

FAQ

- What is the event set up process?
 - Renting parties are responsible for all set up of the event. The lodge and common areas will be deep cleaned prior to your arrival. All tables, chairs and decorations will be clean, stacked and ready for you in the lodge.
- What is the event cleanup process?
 - The renting party is responsible for all cleanup of the event. The venue will be deep cleaned prior to your arrival and must be left as it was found upon your departure, including all trash removal from the property. We provide cleaning supplies and a cleaning checklist. You may opt out of cleaning for an additional fee of \$2,000.00 with the Weekend Wedding Package or you'll see it is included in the All Inclusive Package.
- Do you require a damage deposit with the venue rental?
 - Yes, a seperate damage deposit check of \$2,000.00 is due with your signed contract. If there are no damages and all Terms & Conditions are followed, the damage deposit check will be returned to the renting party no later than 10 days after the event. Violation of this agreement and/or excessive cleaning or damage may result in, and is not limited to, the loss of all or part of the damage deposit. Damage and fees for excessive cleaning more than the damage deposit are the responsibility of the Event Host.
- Do you require event insurance?
 - Yes, the renting party is responsible for obtaining a \$1,000,000 Event Liability Insurance coverage through an insurance provider listing Showdown Montana as an additional insured, to protect you and the venue.
